- Observability, reconciliation, replay controls and operational runbooks.
- Cutover planning, controlled rollback, knowledge transfer and handover.

DELIVERY CONTROLS

- Requirements and decisions linked to source evidence.
- Automated tests and repeatable deployment evidence where the environment permits.
- Security, privacy, accessibility and retention controls tailored to the contract.
- Human approval for production changes and releases.

ENGAGEMENT MODEL

OMEGACORTEX LLC contracts and leads U.S. engagements from Washington. Work is scoped around the customer’s landscape, interface inventory, service levels, authorization boundary and transition constraints.

U.S. STAFFING BOUNDARY

U.S. delivery is performed by personnel engaged for the U.S. contract. Antonio Lozada serves solely as an external technical adviser; he is not part of the U.S. delivery team, is not proposed as contract personnel and does not perform work on U.S. Government contracts.

EVIDENCE LEVEL

Enterprise integration experience and engineering methods are presented separately from bounded prototypes and proposed contract controls. No customer, agency authorization, certification or production outcome is implied unless specifically identified and substantiated.
